I. Call Meeting to Order

The meeting started at 12:03 pm.

II. Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting

Duane requested a motion to approve the May 18, 2016 minutes. Dan moved to approve the minutes, and Shaun seconded. Minutes approved.

III. Update (Crestview WSA, Bennor and Lead/Copper)

Crestview signed a Water Service Agreement for 176 lots for Level B Service (intermittent service). If Crestview is annexed in future, it will remain as an Improvement District and operate its own distribution system, retaining ownership with the City supplying water.

Bennor came online May 17, 2016, and used 432,000 gallons the first month of service. Bennor passed their Lead/Copper sampling after receiving City water. Prior to this, the subdivision had exceeded limits of the regulation.

Levi gave an update on the pipeline as far as completion date (May of 2017) and what needs to happen to reach this goal. The new system will provide 23 MG (million gallons) compared to the 12 MG we have now. The City will have 5 additional wells as part of this project.

IV. Project and Construction Tour

The group took two vehicles and toured well sites from Force Road to Skyline, met at Bennor and then went to the Gillette West Pump Station.
