Public Meeting for Donkey Creek Drainage & Dalbey Park Improvements Scheduled for May 21

GILLETTE, Wyoming- The City of Gillette will host a meeting to review initial drafts of two related study projects for future improvements at Dalbey Memorial Park and the Donkey Creek Drainage corridor. The meeting will be held in the Second Floor Community Room at City Hall, located at 201 E. 5th Street in Gillette on Wednesday, May 21, 2025 beginning at 5:30 p.m.

Both study projects have been ongoing since early summer 2024 and have incorporated feedback through multiple public engagement opportunities, including workshops and surveys. The purpose of the Donkey Creek Drainage Study is to identify and develop preliminary designs, cost estimates, and project prioritization for flood mitigation projects along the creek. The goal of the Dalbey Memorial Park Improvements Study is to guide future design and improvement efforts to park facilities, including the Fishing Lake.

During the May 21 meeting, community members will have the opportunity to see some of the improvements proposed, review findings and generally discuss the future of Dalbey Park and the Donkey Creek drainage corridor. Light refreshments will be served.
