How do I locate my lost pet?

Contact the Animal Shelter immediately should your pet become lost. If an Animal Control Officer finds your pet, and it has tags on it, they will make every effort to contact you to get your pet back.

What animals must be licensed?

Any cat or dog in the City of Gillette over the age of 3 months?



How much does it cost to license my pet?

Unsterilized animals \$20.00

Sterilized animals (spayed or neutered) ... \$ 3.00

YOU MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF CURRENT RABIES VACCINATION & STERILIZATION

Do I have to license my pet every year?

Yes, your animal license must be renewed yearly as they expire one year from the date of purchase.

What happens to pet owners who don't license their pets?

Pet owners who don't license their pets are subject to a fine which carries a penalty of \$85.00 per violation per animal.

How do I license my pet?

License tags may be purchased at the City/County Animal Shelter at 950 W. Warlow Drive or by mailing in the information to:
