Walmart's two-year, \$2.7 billion investment in its U.S. workforce includes more than \$1.8 million for additional raises to associates in Wyoming

Investment provides 1,400 additional raises to Walmart workers in the state

CHEYENNE, Wyo., Dec. 16, 2015 – Walmart is making a \$2.7 billion investment over two years in its U.S. workforce to raise wages, provide better training and increase scheduling choice and flexibility. As part of this commitment, the company is investing nearly \$1.8 million, resulting in 1,400 additional raises for associates in

Wyoming. By February, the new full-time average hourly wage in Wyoming will be \$13.56 an hour and \$11.69 an hour for part-time associates.

Over the past year, Walmart has increased wages in three phases beginning in April by moving its starting rate to at least \$9 an hour. In July, the company increased wages for more than 100,000 associates in specialized positions, like wireless or deli associate, and department managers. In February 2016, Walmart will raise wages for associates hired before Jan. 1, 2016 to at least \$10 an hour, \$2.75 an hour above the federal minimum wage; hourly managers of the company's more complex and service-oriented departments will earn at least \$15 an hour. Associates hired beginning Jan. 1, 2016 will start at \$9 and move to at least \$10 after successfully completing the company's new Pathways training program.

The company is starting to see a return on its investments. Since the first phase of pay raises went into effect, Walmart's customer experience scores and associate engagement numbers have increased. The company also announced during its third quarter earnings that U.S. comp-store sales were positive for the fifth straight quarter and customer traffic was positive for the fourth straight quarter.

Wages are just one part of Walmart's commitment to providing associates the tools they need to grow with the company and provide great customer service. The company is also opening doors for existing and new associates by increasing scheduling flexibility and providing new training opportunities for continued advancement beyond entry-level jobs. Storm Event Overview:

Before this event started, Administrator Napier declared a level 1 snow emergency on 12/14/15, due to 6-9 inches of snow that was being forecast. On 12/15/15 at 12:30 a.m. the night shift was called out by the Streets Supervisor due to blowing snow and slick conditions. The night shift plowed and applied material to priority 1's, 2's and trouble areas until day shift came in at 7:00 a.m. The day shift plowed and applied material to priority 1's, 2's and trouble areas until 11:00 a.m. At this time it was snowing so hard that we could not keep up with everything, so we backed off to plowing priority 1's only until 7:00 p.m. At this time the snow had let off and the night shift went back to plowing and applying material to priority 1's, 2's and trouble areas until 5:00 a.m. At this time the snow had stopped and priorities were holding. The night shift started in subdivisions until the day shift came in at 7:00 a.m. The day shift continued in subdivisions until 10:00 a.m. At this time it had started snowing again and the day shift had to go back to plowing and applying material to priority 1's, 2's and trouble areas until the night shift came in at 7:00 p.m. The night shift continued on priority 1's, 2's and trouble areas until 5:00 a.m. At this time the snow had stopped and all priorities and trouble areas were holding. The night shift went back into subdivisions until the day shift came in at 7:00 a.m. The day shift continued in subdivisions until 12:15 p.m. At this time all priorities were still holding and all subdivision roads had been plowed and material was applied to all hills, corners, trouble areas and major intersections and the event was ended.

Contractor Work Effort:

Pro Built Homes cleared the handicap ramps on Gillette Avenue five times during this event. Earthworks performed a downtown clean-up on Gillette Avenue on 12/18/15.

Subdivision Activities:

We plowed all subdivision roads one time during this event. We applied material to all hills, corners, trouble areas and major intersections within subdivisions one time during this event.

Parks Division Activities:

Parks staff cleaned and maintained all City owned parking lots and facilities. They also cleared 105 miles of city maintained pathways.

Unit #157 went down on 12/15/15 due to windshield wiper motor. Was back in service in one hour.

Unit #126 went down on 12/16/15 due to sander motor. Was back in service in one hour.

Unit #100 went down on 12/16/15 due to hydraulic issues. Was back in service in 2 hours.

Unit #45 went down on 12/16/15 due to electrical issues. Unit is still down.

Incidents:

A Parks Operator backed into a parked vehicle in a City leased parking lot at the Post Office, causing minor damage. The driver was issued a citation.

Complaints / Concerns:

We received several compliments and complaints via e-mail, Facebook, and phone calls during this event. Most of the complaints were from citizens who were upset that we had not been able to get to their subdivision yet. All citizens were called back and their complaints were taken care of before the event ended.

Items of Interest:

Before this event began, we had determined that the conditions were right for pre-treating the roads with our blended liquid. We treated all priority 1's and 2's and some trouble areas. We used 6,000 gallons. The liquid did work and it did help us for the first 12 hours of this event.

During this weather event, the Gillette Police Department investigated 20 vehicle crashes. Five of these crashes occurred on a City of Gillette maintained roadway and were influenced by weather conditions.
