



City of Gillette Fleet Maintenance Recognized by the ASE Blue Seal of Excellence Program

The City of Gillette Fleet Maintenance has earned membership and acceptance into the Blue Seal of Excellence Program. This program is certified by the National Institute for Automotive Service of Excellence (ASE); a non-profit organization dedicated to improving the quality of vehicle repair and service by means of voluntary testing and certification for automotive repair and service professionals.

To be eligible for this recognition, a company must have 75% of its automotive professionals ASE certified. It is mandatory that an organization have a certified technician in each of the 8 automotive specialty service areas.

1. Engine Repair
2. Automatic Transmission / Transaxle
3. Manual Drive Train & Axles
4. Suspension & Steering
5. Brakes
6. Electrical / Electronic Systems
7. Heating & Air Conditioning
8. Engine Performance

ASE was founded in 1972 as a non-profit independent organization dedicated to improving the quality of automotive service and repair through the voluntary testing and certification of automotive technicians. Technicians, engine machinists, and parts specialists have participated in ASE' program from all segments of the service and repair industry such as car and truck dealerships, service stations, independent repair shops, leasing and rental businesses, fleet repair facilities, franchised outlets, etc. Today, more than 400,000 automotive professionals are ASE certified.

Currently there are only 1,435 businesses nation wide that have been awarded the Blue Seal of Excellence. Within this elite group currently only 114 recognized government/civil service agencies exist. The City of Gillette Fleet Maintenance is the only recognized governmental entity within the state of Wyoming!
