# **Toy Store Needs a "FOREVER" Home!**

## **Please help...**

All of our toys stay LOCAL....we have been helping needy children in all of NE WY for over 25 years. These areas include; Gillette, Wright, Rozet, Moorcroft, Sundance, Hulett, Upton and Newcastle. We work with the Council of Community Services or their local entities in each of these areas, as well as the other organizations here to insure that the children have a Merry Christmas!

All of our toys you see when you shop have been donated by people in **OUR** community. We also accept monetary donations that we use to purchase items in age groups that are lacking donated gifts. Even with today's economy, we are very fortunate to live in such a generous community. Our Toy Store is different than some of the other programs out there, in that we actually get to meet the parent/guardian of these children and help *them* shop according to their child's area of interests or needs and not just a list of wants. This year we are expecting to exceed last year, which was over 900 children that were helped.

All of this would also not be possible without the countless hours that our volunteers, both members of ABATE and non-members, put into the Toy Store. We kick off the month of December with our annual Toy Parade and visit with Santa, held the first Saturday. We also have a "Stuff the Bus" promotion sponsored by Fox Country/Basins Radio and Powder River Transportation that runs from Nov to mid Dec. We put drop boxes at various businesses in town for people to drop off their toys. It takes a lot of time, energy and sacrifices from these volunteers to make this all happen.

Without the **GENEROUS temporary** donation of a building each year to hold the Toy Store, we could not do what we are doing for all of NE WY's children. We set up in November, or when a building is available. When Christmas is over, we have to pack up all of our items and move them to storage. ABATE is looking for a "FOREVER" home to house the Toy Store, and provide a facility that all the Gillette organizations would benefit from all year round.

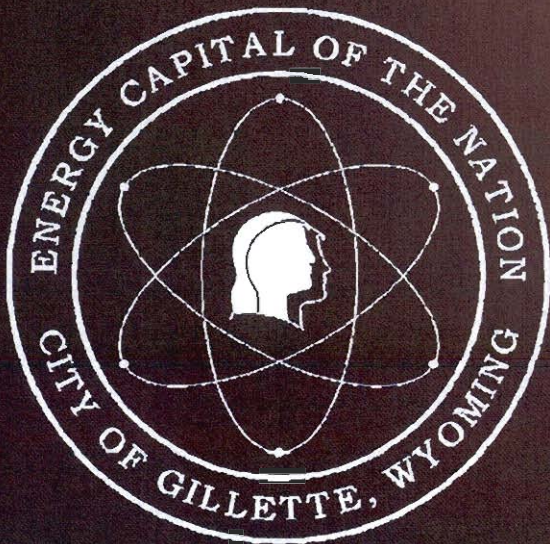
