**PUBLIC NOTICE OF BLASTING
STATE OF WYOMING
COUNTY OF CAMPBELL**

Blasting will be conducted at Thunder Basin Coal Company's Coal Creek Mine; P.O. Box 406, Wright, Wyoming 82732, (307) 464-2700. Blasting will be conducted on a daily basis. From January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, blasting will be located in the East 1/2 of Section 32, in the West half of Sections 22, 27, and 34, and in all of Sections 21, 28, and 33 of T46N R70W and in the Northeast 1/4 of Section 5 and in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 4 of T45N R70W. Blasting of coal and overburden will occur between sunrise and sunset.

Access to the blasting area will be marked with signs stating "Danger, Blasting Keep Away". Blasting areas containing loaded holes will be posted and unauthorized access restricted by blasting and security personnel. Audible warning of blasting activity will be given by sirens, which can be heard for a distance of at least one-half mile. The first warning will be a one-minute wail siren sound to indicate blast detonation in ten minutes. A one-minute yelp siren sound will indicate blast detonation in one minute and will continue until blast detonation. An all clear, fifteen second wail siren will be sounded after the blast has been detonated and checked for complete explosion.

In unusual situations, it may be necessary to detonate blasts at times other than those specified. This emergency blasting will be done when weather or other conditions present some hazard to normal blasting procedures, when necessary to maintain safe operating conditions, or when necessary for public safety.

Residents or owners of manmade dwellings or structures located within 1/2 mile of the permit term disturbance limit may request a pre-blasting survey by submitting a written request to Thunder Basin Coal Company at the above address or to the Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division, 2100 West 5th Street, Sheridan, Wyoming 82801.

Storm Event Overview:

The Streets on-call person was called out by the Police Department about 9:30 p.m. on 11/1/17 due to snow and slick conditions. The Streets night crew leader and another crew member came in and began assisting the on-call person with slick areas around town. Temperatures allowed the falling snow to melt in many areas and the slick areas were successfully handled within a few hours.

By 7:00 a.m. on 11/2/2017, some areas of town had re-frozen and both Streets crews deployed to address slick spots. There was little to no actual accumulation of snow to plow so crews applied scoria/ Ice Slicer blend or brine to slick spots. New concrete areas were treated with scoria alone.

Temperatures began to rise, areas melted off and the event was ended at 10:00 a.m.







Board Members present: Chairman Jaye Drake, John Alt, Weston Scott, Dale Phipps, Scott Heibult, Todd Newlin, and Chris Weight.

Board Members absent: Vice Chairman Dean Thompson, and Chad Renken.

Staff Members present: Heath VonEye, City Engineer/Interim Development Services Director; Ken Rogers, Chief Building Official; Jim Brown, Deputy Building Official; Kim King, Administrative Assistant.

Jaye Drake, Chairman, called the meeting to order.

Approval of Minutes

Chairman Drake called for approval of the September 12, 2017, Regular Meeting Minutes. It was moved by John Alt, seconded by Chris Weight to approve said Minutes. Roll was called on the motion with the following results. Board Members voting aye: Alt, Scott, Phipps, Heibult, Newlin, Weight, and Chairman Drake. Motion carried.

Unfinished Business

New Business

Ken Rogers asked Chairman Drake to call for a motion to discuss the 2017 National Electrical Code (NEC) Ordinance Adoption. Chairman Drake called for a motion. It was moved by Chris Weight, seconded by Weston Scott to discuss the approval of the 2017 NEC Ordinance Adoption.

Ken Rogers informed the Board that the State of Wyoming adopted the 2017 NEC on July 1, 2017. He stated the adoption would go for a first reading at the November 7, 2017 Council Meeting. He stated Delbert Parks and Wes Wagner attended the IAEL Conference in Thermopolis, Wyoming, to review the latest electrical code updates in the 2017 NEC. Ken updated the Board on some of the Code changes.

Chairman Drake informed the Board of the fall session of the Board Member Training. The Board was reminded to attend one of the classes if they had not yet done so.


