

GENERAL FUND SALES TAX ACTIVITY-FY 2018/19







RE: Proposed Transfer of Fiber Assets to CCSD #1

Years ago, we agreed to install and maintain fiber service to the School District facilities within the City of Gillette. In exchange, the School District provided their radio frequency for the City to use with our Mobile Tech program. Our Mobile Tech program previously provided data communications to our mobile equipment that primarily served our Police Department vehicles and other City equipment. The Mobile Tech radio frequency was recently decommissioned. The City now relies on other providers for data frequencies for our mobile equipment. Due to the retirement of the Mobile Tech frequency, our commitment to provide and maintain fiber service to School District facilities is no longer required. We currently serve thirteen school facilities with fiber.

City Staff recommends that all fiber optic assets serving School District facilities that are not currently part of our backhaul fiber system be transferred to the School District through a quit-claim deed process. The value of the fiber assets is similar to the value of the radio frequency that was recently retired. It is our understanding the School District will contract with a local Internet Service Provider (ISP) to operate and maintain fiber optic and broadband services for their school facilities.

We have one small wrinkle with the proposed asset transfer. The City's Gillette Public Access division (GPA) is currently set up to broadcast from three of the school facilities for special events like sporting events and School District Board meetings. These facilities include:

1. Thunder Basin High School
2. Campbell County High School
3. School District Administration Building.

With the transfer of the fiber assets we will draft a separate agreement to hand off designated fibers at a suitable location to continue to maintain GPA service at the above referenced locations.

The assets to be transferred to the School District are summarized as follows:

This year, we again conducted the Community Wide Drive and Drop event as a service to our citizens, allowing them to bring their unwanted metal, demo material, and municipal solid waste to a drop off location. We had three drop off locations for three consecutive Saturdays - April 20th, April 27th, and May 4th. The locations were the ECSC, the Little League fields at Dalbey Park, and Sage Valley Junior High.

Below are the tonnages and associated costs for the event. We budgeted \$80,000 of 1% Beautification money to cover the costs of the event.

Why does the Water Division flush hydrants?

- Hydrant flushing is used to improve water quality and flow rates.
- Hydrant flushing is preventative maintenance for the water distribution system. Releasing water at high velocities from hydrants scours and scrubs water mains. This dislodges films, removes sediments and deposits, and helps control corrosion.
- While flushing the hydrants, crews will also test flow rates and work the valves on hydrants. This tests the hydrants to make sure they are ready to protect our community from fire.
- Results from these tests will be used to mark hydrants so firefighters can quickly assess flow capabilities.
- The results are also used by the Insurance Service Office to rate Gillette's fire suppression abilities. Better ratings result in lower commercial and residential insurance premiums.
