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SECTION 1

1 Introduction

The purpose of this study is to develop estimated construction costs for each of the Improvement and Service Districts (ISD) that may potentially connect to the proposed Regional System (Regional System), for use in the development of a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA). The water service extension concepts identified in the recently completed Gillette Regional Master Plan Level I Study (Master Plan) for the Wyoming Water Development Commission (WWDC) served as the basis of design for providing service to 42 potential regional system participants, using 11 different water delivery systems extending from the Gillette water system. The Master Plan was prepared in cooperation with the City of Gillette (City) and Campbell County (County), both of which will be involved in the development of the JPA.



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
