

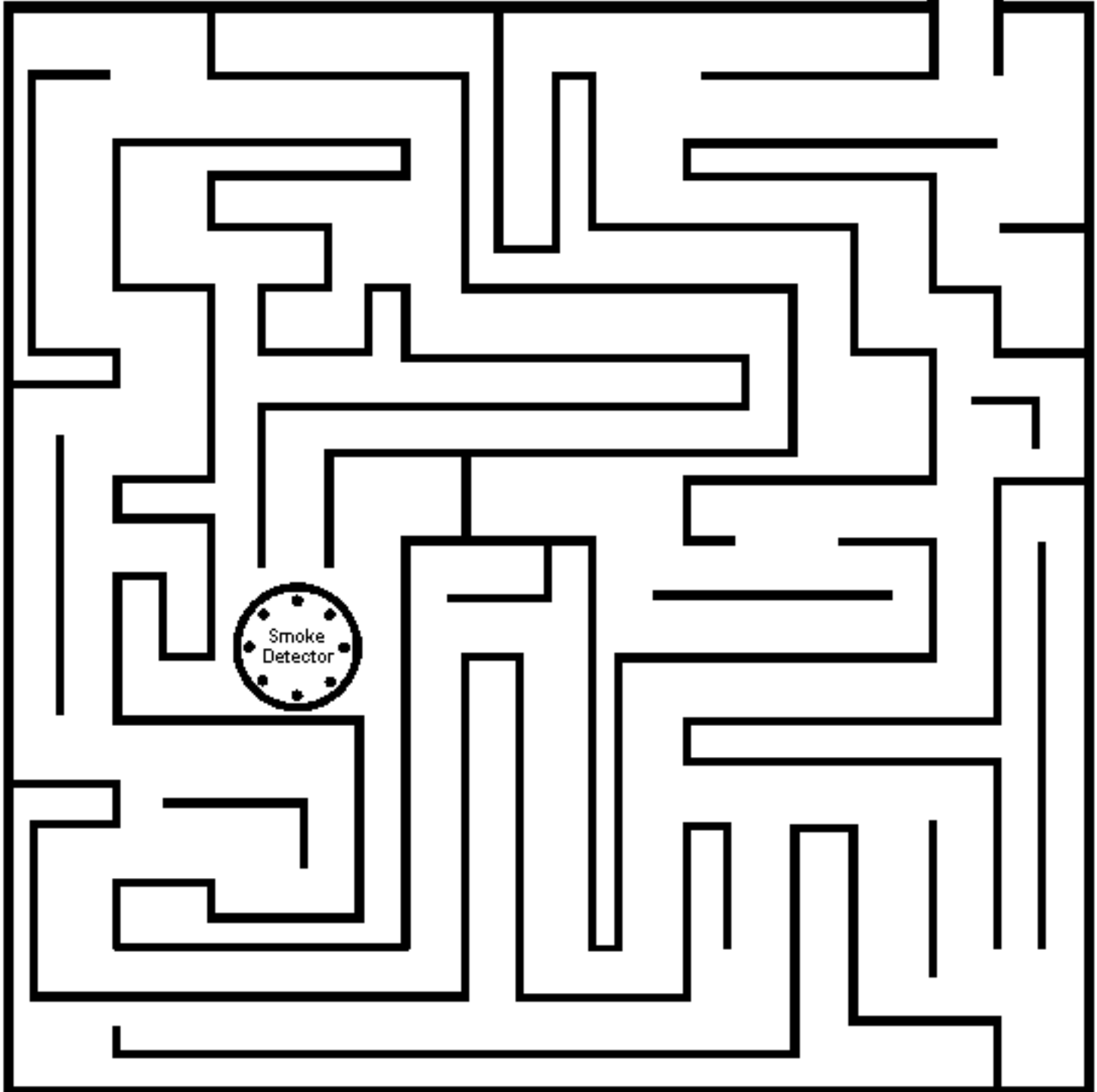


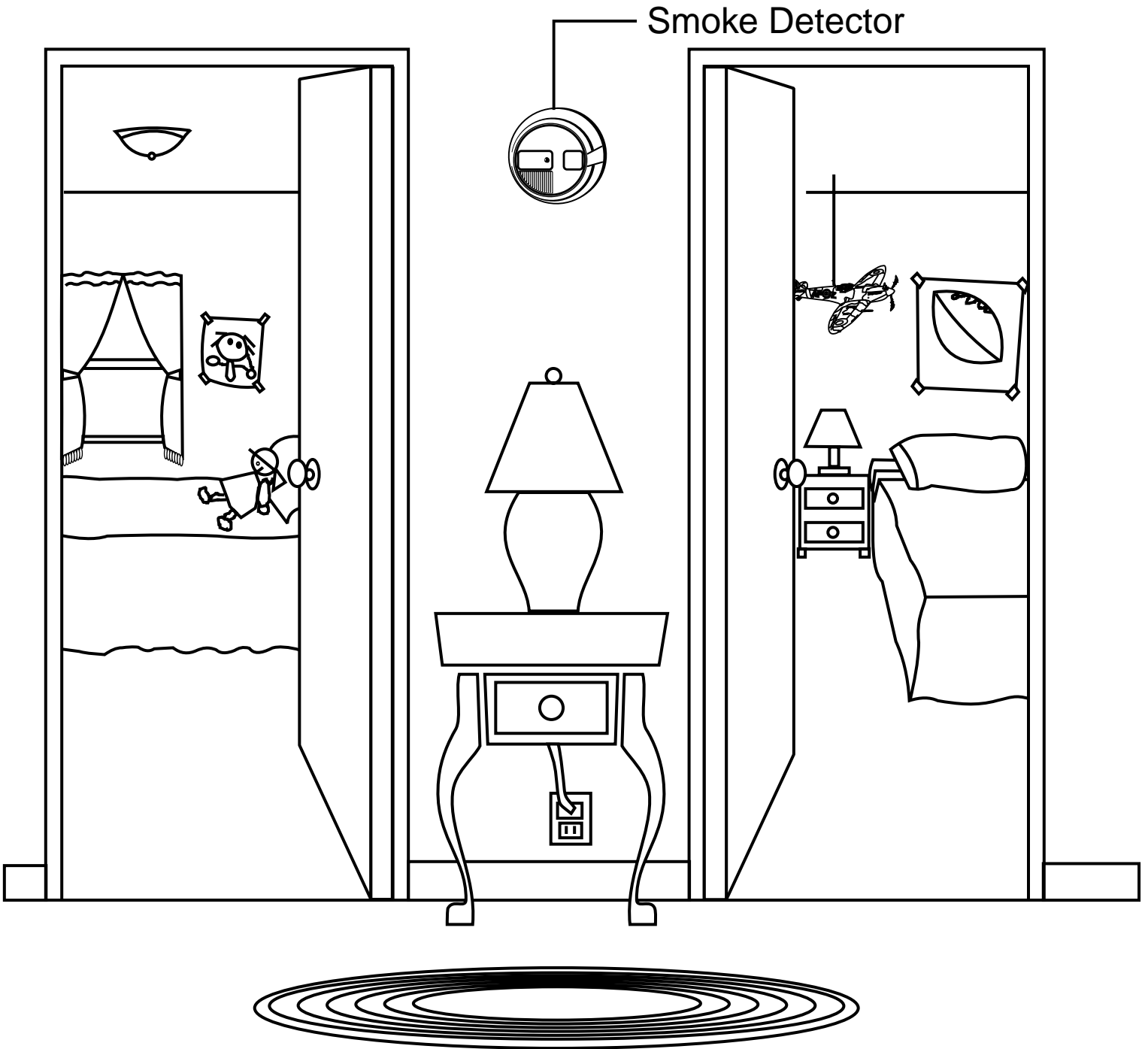
# Help install the smoke detector.



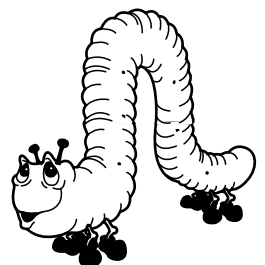
Smoke detectors

your home.

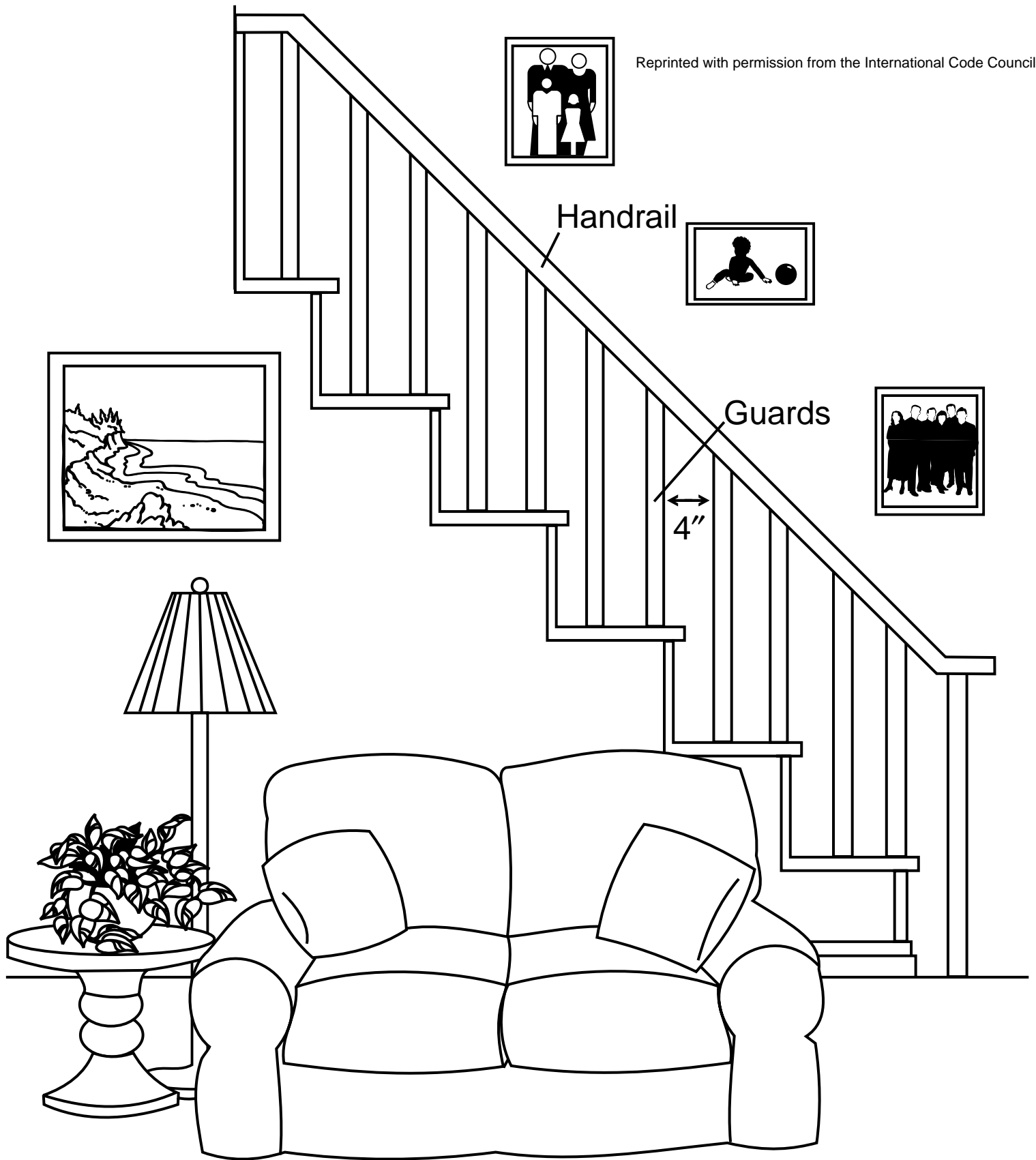

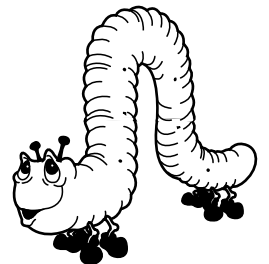


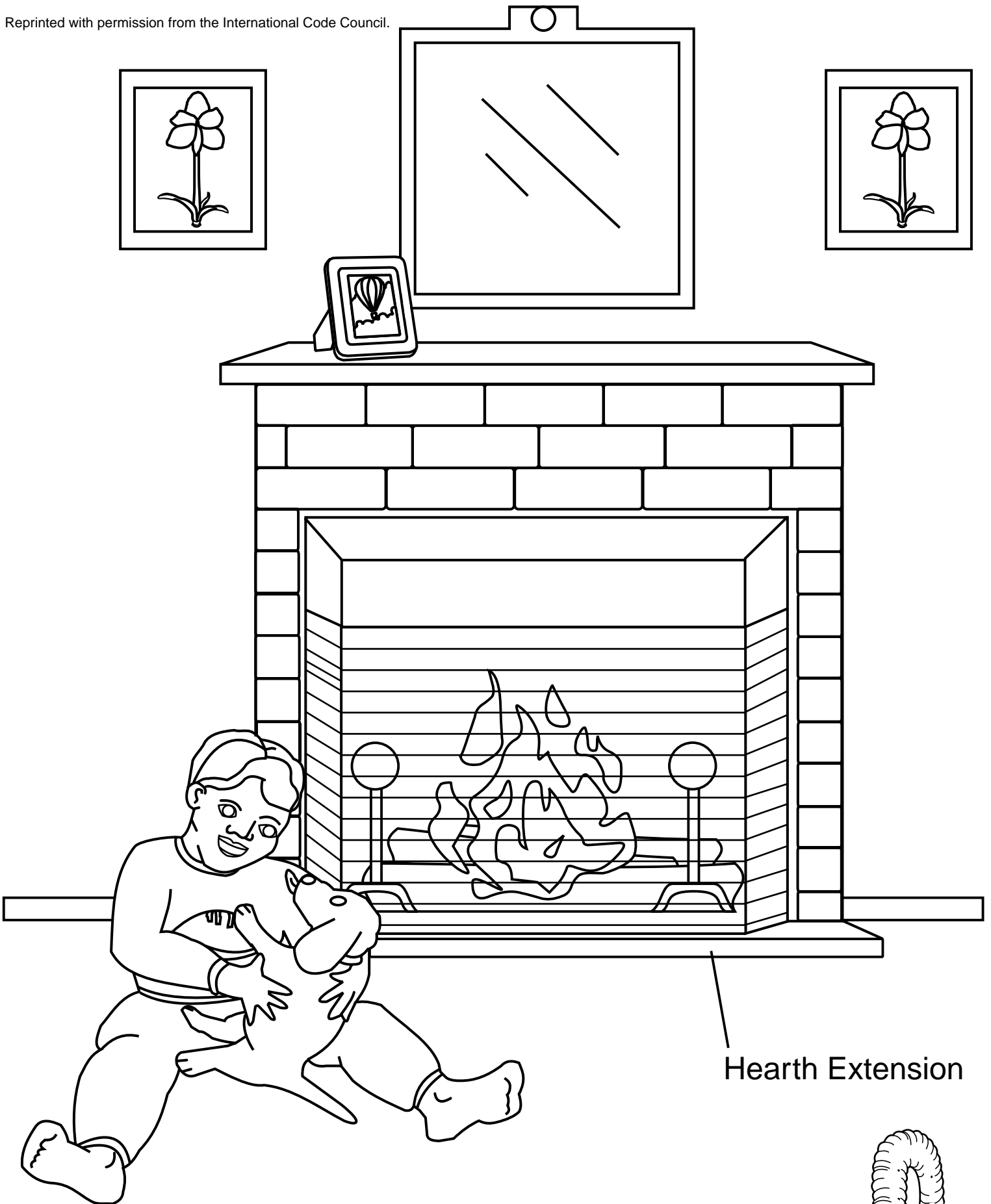
Do you have a smoke detector near where you sleep? Does it work? If not, ask your mom or dad to put up a smoke detector near the bedrooms and make sure it works.





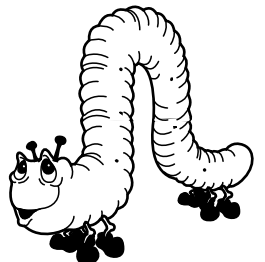

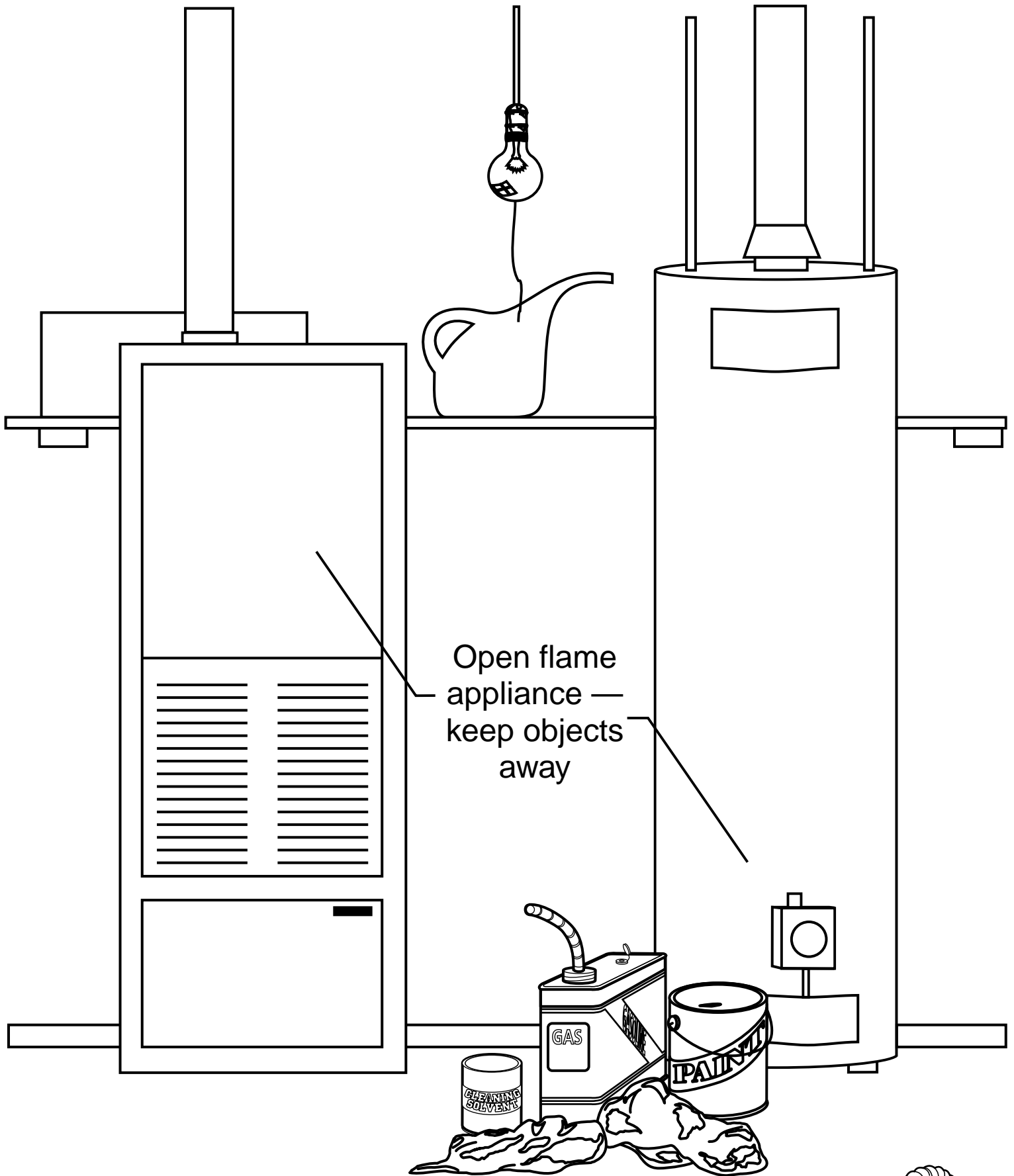




Hearth Extension

Does your fireplace have a hearth extension? (That's the brick or stone slab in front of the fireplace.)

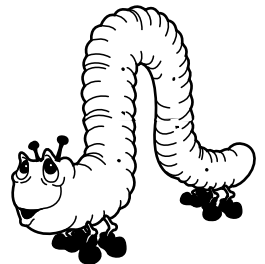


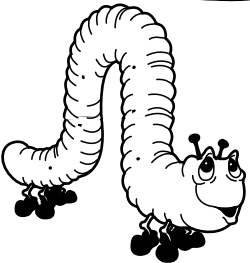

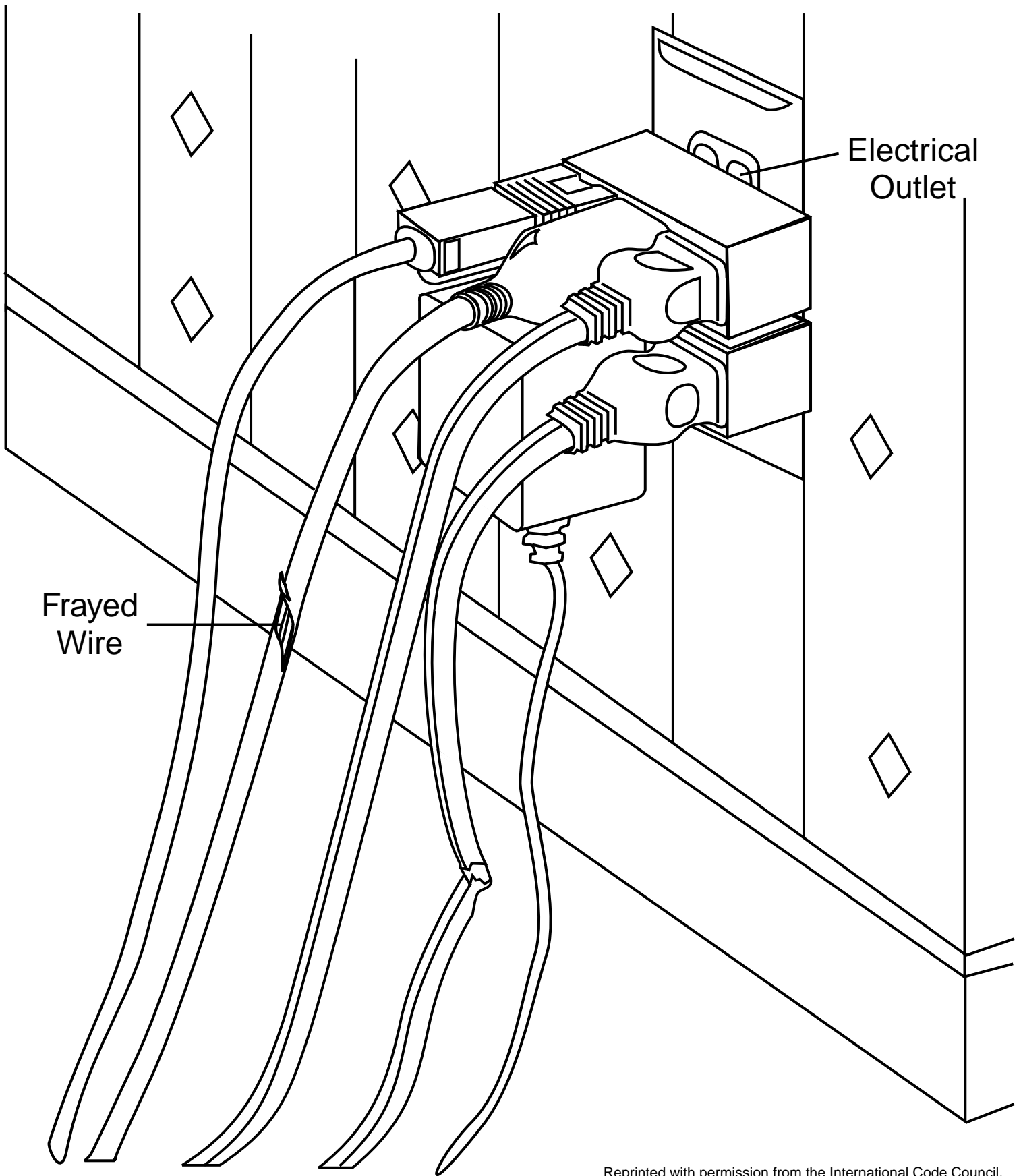

near the heater.



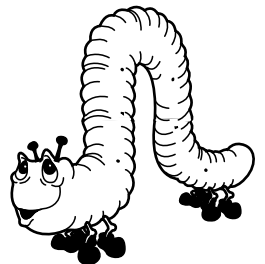


Ask your mom or dad if your bathtub or shower is protected so that the water cannot get too hot.



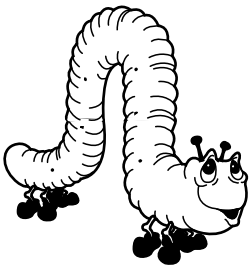
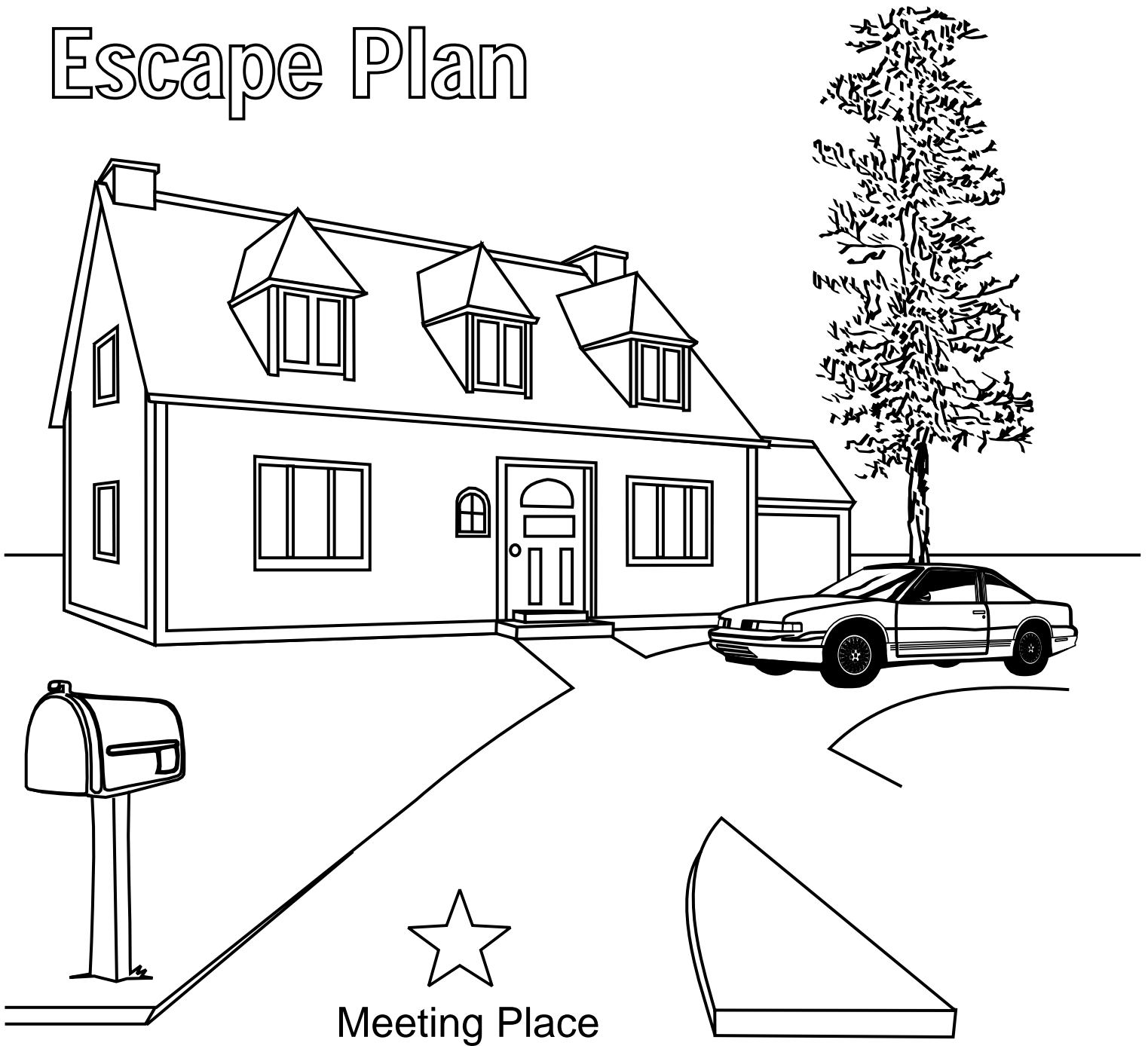
